Team and Player Requirements

- Equipment Requirements – Fielding mask is required
- Uniform Requirements
- Team Banner Requirements
- Team Sponsor Requirements (\$500) Due by March 1

Volunteer Requirements

- 8 hours for 1 child
- 10 hours for 2 or more children
- 2 hours must be in the Snack Shack (Coaching, Dugout staff, and Team Sponsor exempt)
- Umpire – Must umpire a minimum of 5 games to complete hours
- Refundable \$200 check (Will not receive jersey without check) NO CASH
- Must sign up for volunteer hours on Team Sideline (Snack Shack, Trash, Field Prep)
- Complete hours by May 15 and document on Team Sideline by your head coach/team. Checks will be cashed by June 1 for families that did not complete volunteer hours or donated volunteer hours.
